Fondazione Lualdi - AVRO

Located in Rivoli di Osoppo, in the heart of Friuli Venezia Giulia, the AVRO LIKH airfield is a prime destination for aviation enthusiasts. Covering an area of 30,000 square metres, the facility includes a 2,250-square-metre hangar, a clubhouse with a 100-square-metre control tower and a full range of services for pilots and visitors.

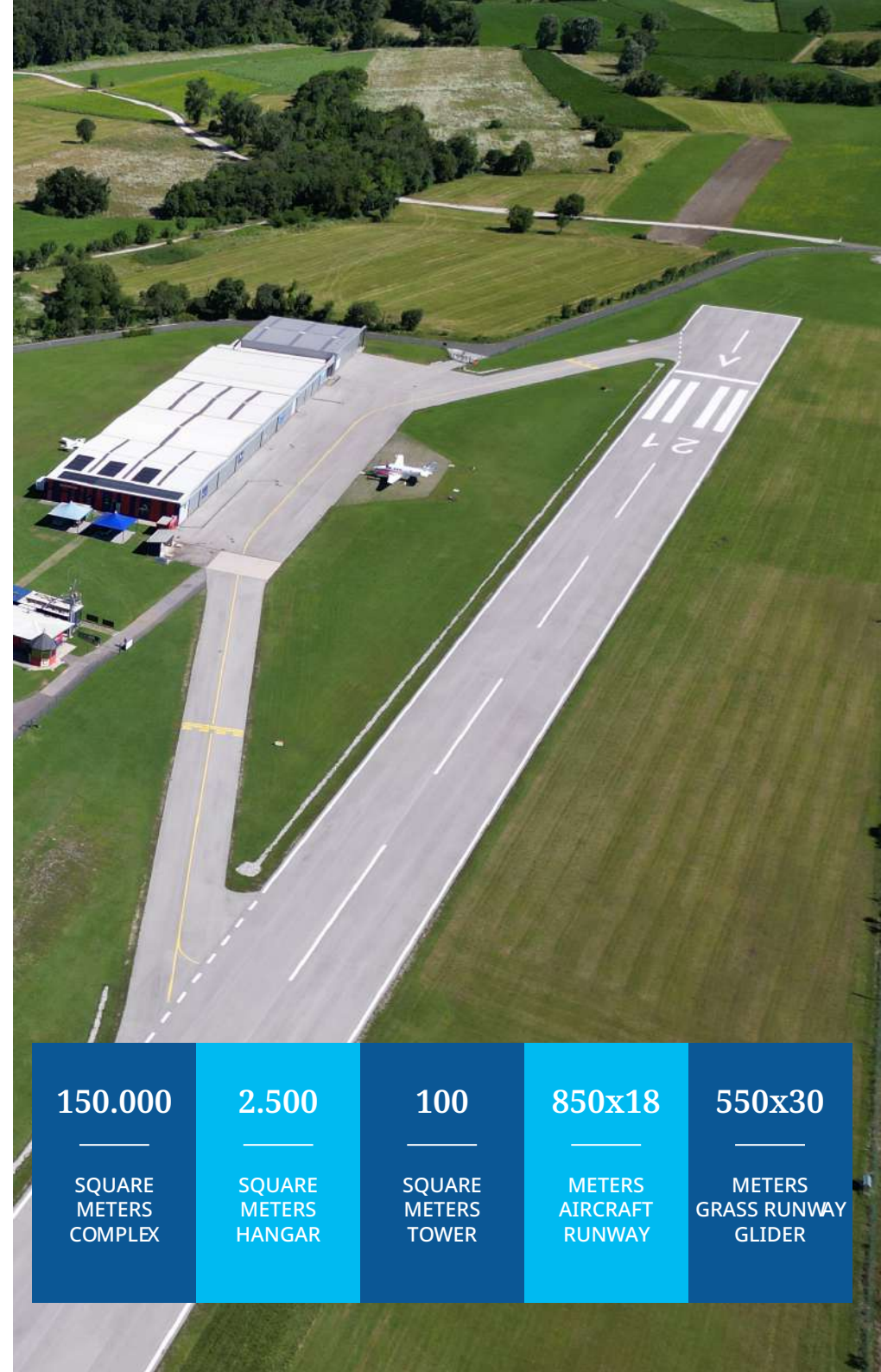
AVRO LIKH operates at the private 'Nino Pittini' airfield in Rivoli di Osoppo, which was adapted and paved by the Lualdi Foundation for use by general aviation. The facilities aim to train professional figures required by civil aviation such as mechanics, pilots, assistants and air traffic controllers.

AVRO wishes to further develop both the civil protection system for emergencies and the health system thanks to its strategic location that shortens the distances between the city and the mountains.

The Lualdi Foundation promotes, disseminates and supports the development of the culture of flight. Its objective is to realise or support training projects in the aeronautical and aerospace sectors, in agreement with the universities and high schools of the Autonomous Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia or with bodies, companies and consortia that emanate from them or in which they participate.

The airport is also ideal as a landing point for business reasons due to its strategic location near many important companies.

The Lualdi Foundation also intends to set up or support exhibition and museum activities aimed at enhancing the culture and history of flight and to recover and preserve the environmental and historical heritage relating to flight in the Region.

Hangar

The airfield has 4 metal hangars (20x25m, 3.30m height under beam, 19m maximum wingspan) that can accommodate more than 30 aircraft.





Control tower

Located inside the clubhouse and unmanned, the control tower is equipped with a radio with a frequency of 122.610 Mhz, with a weather station that is updated live on www.avro.it, landing is permitted until sunset.



Refuelling

Fuel is available to drivers: Mogas, Avgas 100LL and Jet A-1.
The service is self-service.



Club House

Space with courtesy kitchen for pilots and toilets.
After landing, you must go to this facility to register and meet the airfield staff.



Briefing Room

A room designated for meetings where you can remain for the duration of your visit.



Simulator

Simulator

Inside the clubhouse there is a teaching room where lessons are held and a flight simulator is available.

Restaurant

Adjacent to the surface, a bar and restaurant service with panoramic view of the mountains, for pilots who wish to have lunch directly on the airfield.



Courtesy car and bike

The Lualdi Foundation gives guests the opportunity to use a courtesy car to visit the region's sights and enjoy the scenery (7-seater Touran) and mountain bikes for a trip around the airfield.



Camping

The site has a large green area where guests can camp and enjoy the scenery during their stay.
